ASSISTING VICTIMS OF VIOLENT CRIME WITH CRIME RELATED EXPENSES

Who qualifies?

- Victims who have suffered physical injury or extreme mental distress because of a violent crime.
- The crime must have occurred in New Mexico.
- The crime must be reported to a licensed medical provider, licensed mental health provider, tribal health provider, or law enforcement agency.
- The victim or claimant must cooperate fully with the New Mexico Crime Victims Reparation Commission, and a completed application must be filed within a reasonable time.

Who may file the application?

- Victim or parent/guardian of a minor victim.
- Family or dependents of deceased victims.
- Any individual who voluntarily assumes the funeral or medical expenses of the victim.

Types of eligible expenses:

Benefits up to a maximum of \$20,000 can be made for the following:

- Medical and dental care
- Mental health counseling
- Other medically necessary devices
- Funeral and burial expenses
- Loss of earnings
- Reimbursement of co-pays
- Travel for medical appointments and court dates
